Volunteer tutors are always welcome at the Sue Duncan Children's Center. The Center keeps a low tutor-to-student ratio of 1 tutor to no more than 5 students in a group (as opposed to Chicago Public School requiring no more than 32 kids per teacher and often climbing to as many as 40 students). Our tutors work one-on-one and in small groups with children of all ages to help complete homework assignments and improve learning in math, reading and writing. Tutors are also welcome to join the children during gym time later in the day.

Interested volunteer tutors can choose from either of the two Sue Duncan Children's Center campuses based on the location most convenient for them. We facilitate our programming inside local elementary schools on Chicago's south side:

- Original Oakland Campus
Jackie Robinson Elementary School

- New Woodlawn Campus (opened in September 2013)
John Fiske Elementary School
6020 S. Langley Avenue in Chicago
